A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing June 28, 2019, as "National Logistics Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The logistics industry, which includes the
4 packaging, warehousing and shipping of goods, plays an important
5 role in national, state and global economies; and

6 WHEREAS, The logistics industry is responsible for shipping
7 goods via air, truck, rail and sea; and

8 WHEREAS, These shipments can be delivered across town or to
9 countries all around the world; and

10 WHEREAS, Whether delivering raw products to a manufacturer,
11 finished products to a retailer or the consumer getting a
12 product delivered to their door, logistics is critical to
13 society; and

14 WHEREAS, The third-party logistics industry represents an
15 \$800 billion industry; and

16 WHEREAS, According to the United States Department of

1 Transportation, Pennsylvania shipped more than 400,000 tons of
2 goods valued at more than \$278 million just within its borders
3 in 2017; and

4 WHEREAS, It does not matter if a business is a small family
5 operation or a corporation operating globally, without a strong
6 logistics system in place a business cannot succeed, whether it
7 is by truck, rail, air or sea, goods need to be transported to
8 the consumer; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize June
10 28, 2019, as "National Logistics Day" in Pennsylvania.
