WHEREAS, the logistics industry involves obtaining, producing, and distributing products to the correct place and in the correct quantities; and

WHEREAS, logistic services make up about 84% of the \$18.5 billion transportation and warehousing sector in Ohio and about 2.6% of the state's gross domestic product; and

WHEREAS, the industry employs 3.5 million truck drivers in the United States; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 17,000 warehouses operating in the United States, providing more than 215 million square feet of storage; and

WHEREAS, Ohio ranks 5th among all states in warehousing and storage services; and

WHEREAS, rail freight accounts for 16% of U.S. freight shipments by weight; and

WHEREAS, on average, the air freight industry transports about 51.2 million tons of cargo a year; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 20 million shipping containers in the world and almost 6 million of them are currently shipping around the world on ships, trucks, and trains; and

WHEREAS, designating a day in recognition of the significance of logistics would raise awareness of the benefits of that industry to the state's economy; and
