*Whereas, According to the United States Department of Transportation, Pennsylvania shipped more than 400,000 tons of goods valued at more than \$278 million just within its borders in 2017; and*

*Whereas, It does not matter if a business is a small family operation or a corporation operating globally, without a strong logistics system in place a business cannot succeed, whether it is by truck, rail, air or sea, goods need to be transported to the consumer; therefore be it*

*Resolved, That the House of Representatives recognize June 28, 2019, as "National Logistics Day" in Pennsylvania.*
