LOGISTICS PLUS IS A U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) SMARTWAY TRANSPORT PARTNER, AND DEEPLY COMMITTED TO SUSTAINABILITY BEST-PRACTICES.

Logistics Plus is committed to managing our operations in a way that exceeds environmental legislation and standards. We are invested in our collective future, and we continue to provide resources to improve the environment.

Logistics Plus joined the **SmartWay Transport Initiative** in 2010 with the goal of reducing our impact on the environment. Each year, performance data is submitted and reviewed to qualify as a SmartWay partner. Since our involvement began, we have demonstrated our commitment to environmental sustainability by receiving SmartWay approval for 12+ consecutive years.

Logistics Plus continues to contribute to the partnership's savings of 248.9 million barrels of oil, \$33.4 billion in fuel costs and 119 million tons of air pollutants. This is equivalent to the annual electricity use of 16 million homes.

According to the last published rankings, Logistics Plus was among the **top 60** SmartWay Transport Partners with the **lowest amount of carbon emissions per mile**.



OUR PARTNERSHIP WITH ON CEAN INTEGRITY



Ocean Integrity is an organization whose primary efforts are twofold:

- 1. Prevent the introduction of new plastic into the World's Oceans
- 2. Reclaim existing plastic materials that have accumulated in the World's Oceans

Ocean Integrity accomplishes this through innovative techniques that vary based on the size and concentration of the plastic waste material encountered.

OUR SUPPORT

Through its partnership with Ocean Integrity, Logistics Plus **assists with all aspects of supply chain management**. This includes transportation of collected plastic debris, international regulation assistance, cross-border trading, and navigation of customs and global trade compliance.

Logistics Plus is committed to using its global network of customers and partners to connect Ocean Integrity with people who support its mission of restoring integrity to the World's Oceans.


OUR SUSTAINABILITY EFFORTS

Logistics Plus purchase 1,200 recycled, air freight approved pallets made from plastic waste. These pallets are being used at our Erie, PA-based warehouses. This one purchase order of 1,200 pallets helped remove 13,200 pounds of trash from our oceans. Today, Ocean Integrity is building houses and other finished goods with the plastic they collect.

PLASTIC NEUTRALITY

Logistics Plus became the first corporate sponsor to enroll in the Ocean Integrity **Blue Ocean Plastic Neutrality Program** in 2020 by offsetting 19 tons of plastic waste. This program provides companies the opportunity to establish their plastic footprint and reduce it by joining Ocean Integrity to collect marine plastic and waste.

Logistics Plus once again received a Plastic Neutrality Certification in 2021 and 2022. In 2022, Logistics Plus reduced its plastics footprint by supporting the collection of 72,000 pounds of marine plastic and waste.






ELECTRIC FORKLIFTS

Logistics Plus is committed to reducing our carbon footprint. Over the past two years, our warehouses have switched to electric-only forklifts. As we continue to grow, Logistics Plus will purchase ONLY electric forklifts when they are available. Today, we have over 100 electric forklifts in operation at our facilities.








OPTIMIZING & CONSOLIDATING FREIGHT



Logistics Plus utilizes sustainable shipping practices such as mode optimization and lessthan-truckload (LTL) freight consolidation. This freight strategy involves combining multiple LTL shipments – all with a common destination – into a full truckload before shipping it to the destination. Freight consolidations require the higher-level planning in which our team specializes.

One of the many benefits that LTL freight consolidation offers is the reduction of our carbon footprint due to fewer trucks being used.
