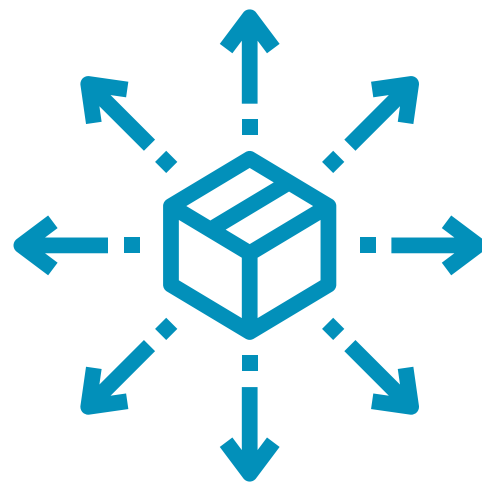
IT'S OFFICIAL

Recognition of National Logistics Day grows with social media, The U.S. House of Representatives issued a formal Congressional Record honoring June 28th as a National Logistics Day, and the States of Ohio and South Carolina both issued formal proclamations as well.
